

SIKKIM – DARJEELING TOUR PACKAGE

04 NIGHT 05 DAYS



Highlights:

- **Gangtok Arrival & Transfer:** Pickup from Bagdogra Airport / New Jalpaiguri Railway Station and transfer to Gangtok. Evening free for leisure.
- **Tsomgo Lake & Baba Mandir:** Half-day excursion to the scenic Tsomgo Lake and visit Baba Harbhajan Singh Mandir. Optional Nathula Pass visit.
- **Gangtok to Darjeeling:** Scenic drive to Darjeeling, the hill station surrounded by tea gardens and Himalayan peaks.
- **Darjeeling Local Sightseeing:** Sunrise at Tiger Hill, visit Padmaja Naidu Zoological Park, Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Tibetan Refugee Self-help Centre, Tenzing & Gombu Rock, Japanese Peace Pagoda, Ghoom Monastery, Batasia Loop, and explore the Mall Road & local market.
- **Departure:** Transfer from Darjeeling to Bagdogra Airport / New Jalpaiguri Railway Station for onward journey.

DAYWISE ITINERARY

Day 01: Arrival in Gangtok – Gateway to the Himalayas

On arrival at Bagdogra Airport or New Jalpaiguri Railway Station, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred on a scenic drive (approx. 114 km / 4.5–5 hrs) to the charming hill town of Gangtok, perched at 5,500 ft above sea level. As you ascend through lush landscapes, rolling hills, and winding mountain roads, soak in the serene Himalayan vistas that surround you. Gangtok, known for its clean streets, vibrant culture, and peaceful monasteries, promises a perfect blend of tranquility and charm. Evening is free to unwind or explore at leisure — take a gentle stroll through the town, enjoy the cool mountain air, or simply relax at your hotel. **Overnight stay in Gangtok amidst the serene Himalayan backdrop.**



Day 02: Gangtok – Excursion to Tsomgo Lake & Baba Mandir

After a hearty breakfast, embark on a breathtaking half-day excursion to the pristine **Tsomgo Lake**, located at an altitude of 12,400 ft and just 32 km from Gangtok. Surrounded by snow-capped peaks, the serene oval-shaped lake (about 1 km long and 15 m deep) is considered sacred by the locals, offering a tranquil and mesmerizing setting for photography and nature walks. Continue 18 km further to visit the revered **Baba Harbhajan Singh Mandir**, a shrine dedicated to the brave soldier, steeped in legend and local devotion. Return to Gangtok in the evening and enjoy leisure time to relax, explore the town, or stroll through its vibrant streets. **Overnight stay in Gangtok, surrounded by the calm Himalayan beauty.**

- **Note:**

- **In case of Land slide or any reason, Tsomgo Lake is closed we will provide alternate sightseeing at Gangtok**
- **Nathula Pass visit will be on direct payment basis because it depends on availability of permit from army and subject to weather & Road Condition**

- **Nathula is closed to visitors on Monday.**



Day 03: Gangtok to Darjeeling – Journey to the Queen of Hills

After breakfast, begin your scenic drive from Gangtok to the charming hill station of Darjeeling (105 km / approx. 4 hrs). Darjeeling, whose name is derived from “Dorje,” the mystic thunderbolt of the Lama religion, was first discovered by British Captain Lloyd in 1829. Nestled amidst rolling tea gardens and framed by some of the highest Himalayan peaks, the town promises a delightful mix of nature, culture, and local Himalayan charm. On arrival, check in to your hotel and spend the evening at leisure — take a stroll through the quaint streets, enjoy the cool mountain breeze, or simply relax and soak in the serene beauty of Darjeeling. **Overnight stay in Darjeeling.**



Day 04: Darjeeling – Sunrise & Local Sightseeing

Rise early for a mesmerizing drive to **Tiger Hill**, where you can witness the first rays of the sun illuminating the majestic **Mount Kanchenjunga**, the world's third-highest peak. The breathtaking sunrise over the Himalayan peaks is an unforgettable experience that sets the tone for the day. After breakfast at your hotel, explore the highlights of Darjeeling, starting with a visit to the **Padmaja Naidu Zoological Park** and the **Himalayan Mountaineering Institute**, where you can learn about mountaineering history and see fascinating exhibits. Continue to the **Tibetan Refugee Self-help Centre**, **Tenzing & Gombu Rock**, and drive past the lush tea estates, before visiting the serene **Japanese Peace Pagoda**. In the afternoon, take in the spiritual and historic charm of the **Ghoom Monastery** and the scenic **Batasia Loop War Memorial**. Conclude your day with a leisurely stroll around the Mall Road and the bustling local market, enjoying the Himalayan ambiance at your own pace. **Return to your hotel for an overnight stay, reflecting on the rich culture and stunning vistas of Darjeeling.**

(Note: Tiger Hill visit is subject to permit availability the previous evening; some attractions may be closed on specific days.)



Day 05: Darjeeling – Departure to Bagdogra / New Jalpaiguri

After a leisurely breakfast, bid farewell to the charming hill station of Darjeeling and begin your scenic drive back to **Bagdogra Airport** or **New Jalpaiguri Railway Station** (approx. 95 km / 3 hrs). As you descend from the hills, take in the last glimpses of tea gardens, rolling valleys, and the serene Himalayan landscapes that have made this journey unforgettable. This marks the end of your memorable trip, carrying home beautiful memories of Gangtok and Darjeeling, their vibrant culture, and breathtaking mountain vistas.
